Turn on the tap, water comes out. Turn on the washing machine, water comes out. The novelty is not only that water comes out but clean water! We all know water is important for basic survival yet why are 1.8 million people dying every year (WHO) because of unsanitary water conditions?

Wells need to be dug to access clean drinking water. These wells not only produce clean water but also minimize the time to access clean water. Usually women would have to walk many kilometres to get to a water source. In many of the countries SIM works, including Burkina Faso, wells need to be dug so communities can access clean water.

Water may seem simple but it has a ripple effect for the community. People don't have to spend as much time getting water so they can spend their time doing other productive activities to support their families. We need people to join with us and provide communities with safe water.

As a side benefit of the centres, the tank serves an above ground storage facility of potable water, allowing for gravity feeding to a water point. This removes the need for hand hauling/pumping by women.

- ► Current Financial Need \$68,000
- > \$20 waters 1 camel and its baby
- > \$100 waters 5 camels
- ▶ \$400 pays for 1 metre of drilling in this very remote location
- > \$1,500 buys a pump or solar panels




